

EAST KNOYLE VILLAGE HALL ALCOHOL LICENCE

The designated premises supervisor is Sara Southerden, May Cottage, The Street, East Knoyle.

It is an offence to sell alcohol to a person under the age of 18 years, a person who is drunk OR a person who is purchasing alcohol for a person under 18 year or who is drunk. The penalty is a maximum of £20,000 and 6 months imprisonment for each occasion of sale.

Where a person appears to be under 21years of age they must be asked to produce photo identification as proof of age before alcohol is sold to them. A driving licence, passport or Portman card is the only acceptable means of proof.

It is an offence to sell alcohol outside the designated hours or to allow its consumption outside the designated hours. The designated hours are shown on the premises licence attached to the notice board in the village hall. It is an offence to allow unruly behaviour in or outside the premises.

The following person is authorised to sell alcohol on the occasion shown. Any person serving alcohol does so only on the authorisation and responsibility of the authorised person.
